JOBS

The main job of any Associate at Kings Island is to provide excellent Guest Service. That means a friendly welcome and positive attitude, knowledge of the Park (we will teach you) to answer questions, appreciation that the guest came to the Park, and patience, understanding and helpfulness when their experience does not meet these expectations.

• Admissions Associate (\$7.30/hour)

You will be taught our Guest Service Standards and all about locations within the Park. At the entrance gate, You will greet guests as they arrive, verify their tickets, and direct them to the location in the Park they are interested in. You must be friendly and make a positive impression. You are the first person guests see. You may also be taught how to use a computer program to sell tickets

• Park Services Sweep (\$8.00/hour)

You will be taught our Guest Service Standards and all about locations and events within the Park. You will use a pan & broom to sweep up small pieces of trash in an area of the Park. You are outside and among the guests who will ask you about Park events and directions to their favorite location. You are also responsible to empty trash containers. Comfort in talking to guests is a must!

• Rides Associate (\$7.30/hour)

You will be taught how to safely operate a ride, such as a roller coaster or other mechanical ride. You will participate in extensive, detailed training, and be very alert to signals and changes while the ride is in operation. You will speak to each guest (using what you learned regarding Guest Service Standards) when you make sure they are safely secured into the ride.

• Merchandise Associate (\$7.30/hour)

You will be in a store within Kings Island and will be taught about the products to sell. You will also be taught how to operate a cash register. You will help guests select products to purchase using Guest Service Standards. You are responsible for the money in your cash register and will count it after your shift. You will also move products from storage rooms to sales areas, where the product will be arranged for display.

• Games Associate (\$7.30/hour)

Games Associates must be high-energy and cannot be shy. You are responsible to speak loudly and get the attention of guests walking by, so they will play your game. You will also use a microphone. You are responsible for a money apron, where you must count and track cash without a cash register. You will be taught how the games work, the rules, and how to award prizes to guests. You must always be friendly and follow our Guest Service standards.

Food & Beverage Associate (\$7.30/hour)

Food Associates prepare, cook, and serve foods and beverages at a variety of restaurants, carts, and stands. You are also responsible for the cleanliness of your location and will wash dishes and empty trash containers. In most positions, you will also be taught how to use a cash register. You must be prepared for a fast-paced environment, taking orders from large numbers of guests and maintaining Guest Service Standards.
